Te Hau Ranga Ora Māori Health Service is available to all families/whānau during the day, on-call after hours and in the weekend.

Access to Te Hau Ranga Ora Māori Health Service is through Whanganui Hospital's information desk by calling **06 348 1234** or by asking staff on the ward. Ask to speak to a haumoana navigator about any of our services or facilities.

The team of haumoana navigators:

- are part of the WDHB hospital and health care team
- support patients and families/whānau during their stay in hospital
- assist family/whānau-centred care by working alongside staff to support and engage with whānau
- advocate for patients and their whānau
- facilitate links back to services in the community
- are available to patients and whānau on all wards.
