On 1 April 2021, under section 12 of the Official Information Act, you requested the following information from Whanganui District Health Board (WDHB):

"How many patients aged under 18 were put into seclusion every year since 01.01.2018 in mental health facilities in your DHB? Could you please give detail of:

- 1. Number of seclusion incidents each year since 2018 until today for patients aged under 12.
- 2. Number of seclusion incidents each year since 2018 until today for patients aged 13-18.
- 3. How long were patients in seclusion over that period and in what conditions? Please provide a breakdown of average, minimum and maximum seclusion duration for each year (2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 to date) for patients aged under 12, and for patients aged 13-18.
- 4. Number of patients put in seclusion each year since 2018 with their age, or age range if possible, and how many times they were placed in seclusion."
